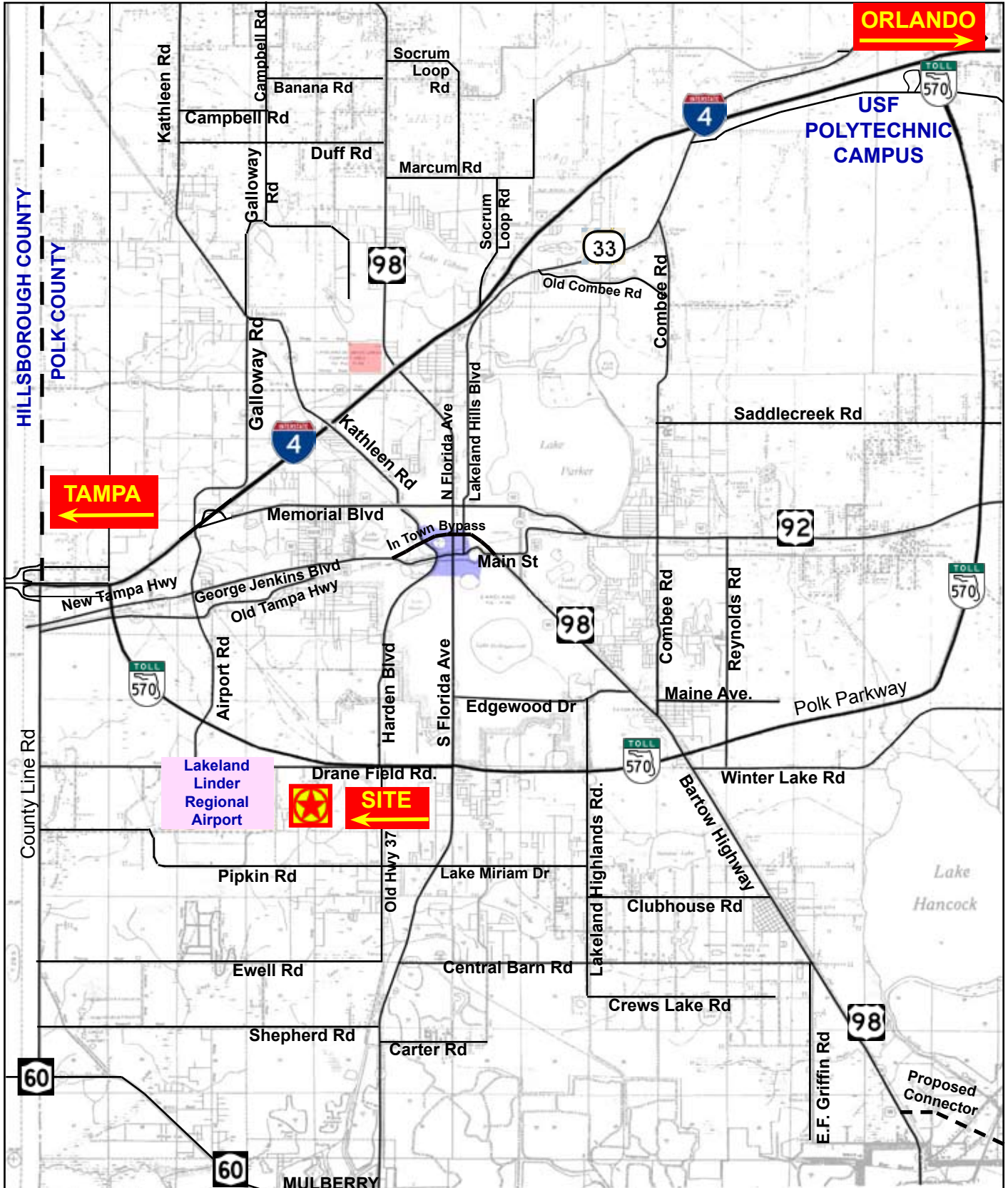




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Greater Lakeland I-4 Corridor Map

Households by Income

Current median household income is \$48,246 in the market area, compared to \$54,442 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$54,431 in five years. In 2000, median household income was \$37,134, compared to \$25,461 in 1990.

Currently, 86.3 percent of the civilian labor force in the identified market area is employed and 13.7 percent are unemployed. In comparison, 89.2 percent of the U.S. civilian labor force is employed, and 10.8 percent are unemployed. In five years the rate of employment in the market area will be 89.3 percent of the civilian labor force, and unemployment will be 10.7 percent. The percentage of the U.S. civilian labor force that will be employed in five years is 91.2 percent, and 8.8 percent will be unemployed. In 2000, 61.0 percent of the population aged 16 years or older in the market area participated in the labor force, and 0.3 percent were in the Armed Forces.

In the current year, the occupational distribution of the employed population is:

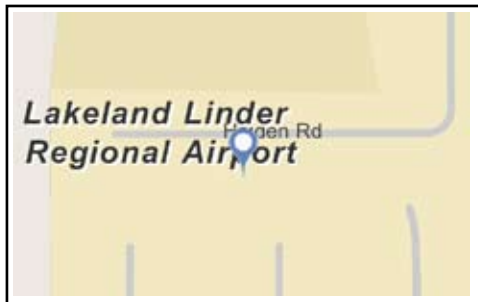
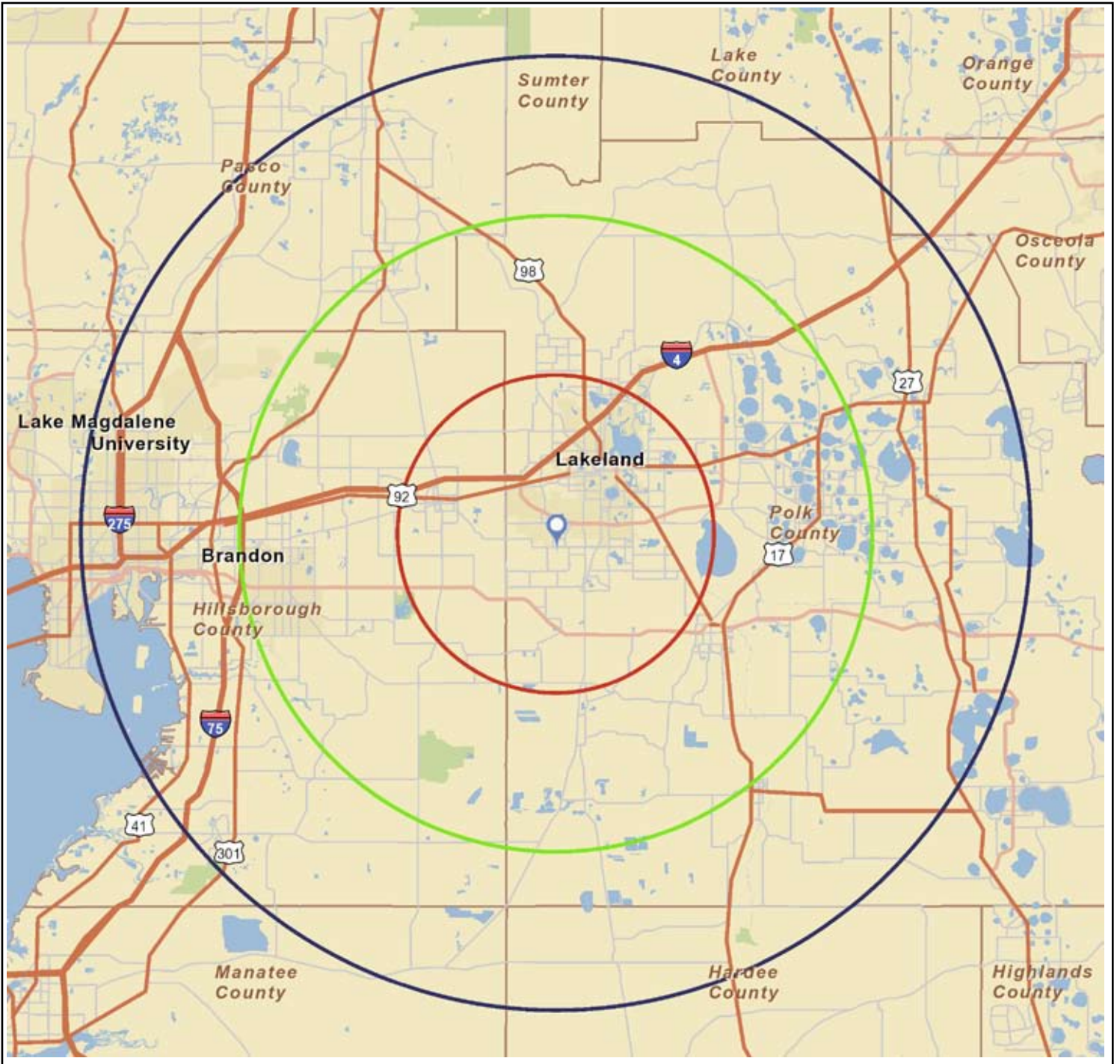
